

#### WHAT A BLESSED EASTER WEEKEND

Every year, thousands of people climb a mountain in the Italian Alps, passing the "stations of the cross" to stand at an outdoor crucifix. One tourist noticed a little trail that led beyond the cross. He fought through the rough thicket and, to his surprise, came upon another station, one that symbolized the empty tomb. It was neglected. The brush had grown up around it. Almost everyone had gone as far as the cross, but there they stopped.

Perhaps far too many of us struggle daily with the weight of the cross trying in our own strength to deny self and too few of us live each day in the power of the empty tomb. The truth is real every day of our lives – Jesus is risen, and He gives us the hope and help to overcome each and every day. Peter said we have a living hope through the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. May we live each day in that living hope, not just at Easter. What a blessed Easter weekend we had with the Carry the Cross and the Easter Worship Services. We had 325 people from our community for the walk with the cross on Good Friday and around 110 from our community gathered early Resurrection Morning for the Mile Branch Easter Sunrise Service.




# DISCIPLING A GENERATION THAT KNOWS CHRIST AND MAKES HIM KNOWN.


